Old and new datasets

The "old data" given here is taken from the first report of Elffers.

To correct the data for JKZ we must account for 2 new incidents outside of Lucia's shifts discovered by Stijn Franken and Metta de Noo (a third incident concerning Kemal and a second concerning Ka, respectively); and 2 incidents in or close to her shifts originally thought by investigators to be associated with Lucia, but dropped in the course of the investigation (Sadia, Sarah).

We understand that the case of Sarah was excluded entirely from the proceedings at a very early stage. It seems that formally speaking this was a euthanasia, and a criminal offense had therefore been committed (possibly in an earlier shift on another ward). Lucia was present in the shift when Sarah died, but had no part at all in the decision making. We believe this case was excluded by Elffers, and we exclude it too.

We must also resolve some confusion concerning an incident with Eda which occurred on a different ward and outside of the time interval specified by Elffers. We presently believe it was correctly excluded by Elffers, and we do the same.

We are altogether aware of 12 incidents at JKZ during the period investigated by Elffers, and the incident with Eda some weeks before and on a different ward¹. We have moved two of these incidents from Lucia's shift into the subsequent shift, since in both cases the events indeed happened some time after the end of her shift while nothing remarkable happened during her shift (Achmad 2nd incident, Sadia). We delete the rather special incident of Sarah. Naturally we also do not include the case of Eda. This leaves us with 11 incidents, of which 7 occurred in Lucia's shifts, 4 outside.

Elffers' original count had 9 incidents all in Lucia's shifts: Eda and Sarah were excluded, and the new cases of Kemal and Ka had not yet been discovered. Later at the order of the court he reduced the count to 8 by excluding also Sadia; this case had in the meantime been dropped by the prosecution. Note that we have counted it as an incident outside of Lucia's shifts.

For RKZ-41, we take account of two new incident-less shifts of Lucia at RKZ-41 discovered by Stijn Franken. There is no consequence for the shifts worked by Lucia at RKZ-42.

For RKZ-42, one incident has been moved from one of Lucia's shifts into the subsequent shift, for the same reasons as before (Mrs. Odenkirchen).
